

## LAPA Molokai Spring Break Trip: March 17-19, 2025

Aloha parents,

Exciting news! LAPA will be doing another performing arts camp with the Hokulani Children's Theatre of Molokai (CTOM) from March 17-19—the Monday-Wednesday of spring break. We will be staying at the same camp grounds we did last year (Molokai Baptist Church). The specific camp itinerary is still in the works, but we would be leaving Lanai on the morning of the 17th on three separate Mokulele flights, and returning on the afternoon on the 19th, also on three separate flights. Please see the back side of this letter for more specific information. Hokulani CTOM is also performing *Flight of the Mothman*, so we think it'll be a really fun opportunity for the LAPA and CTOM students to bond and collaborate.

LAPA can only bring a limited number of student and chaperones, so registration for the camp will be offered first to kids who have speaking roles in *Flight of the Mothman*—this includes all understudies. Students under the age 10 are required to have a chaperone responsible for them.

The cost to attend camp is \$50 per person (including chaperones). This will include all meals, flights, and a camp t-shirt. Payment can be made directly on our website (see “Molokai camp registration tab”).

**For families of students with speaking roles in *Flight of the Mothman*, please let us know by Thursday, February 27 whether your child/children will be able to attend camp.** Parents can message us through the Remind app, email us at [lanaiacademy@gmail.com](mailto:lanaiacademy@gmail.com), or register for the trip on [lanaiacademy.org](http://lanaiacademy.org). If we still have additional space for kids without speaking roles, we will open up registration on a first-come first serve basis after the 27th.

### Tentative itinerary

**Leave Lanai late morning, March 17, fly out Wednesday late afternoon (March 19)**

—chartering 3 separate Mokulele flights both ways, specific times to be determined

### Staying at: Molokai Baptist church

- boys and girls cabins, each cabin sleeps 8-10
- cabins will be mixed with LAPA and CTOM students
- there will be at least one adult LAPA and CTOM chaperone in each cabin
- there are boys/girls bathrooms (cold showers)

### Camp activities:

- during the camp we will be practicing songs, playing theater games, doing group activities, team building games, etc. A more detailed itinerary will be announced soon.
- We will have two large rental vans and on both Tuesday and Wednesday we will be leaving the camp grounds for activities

### Food:

- Monday night will be lasagna/salad, Tuesday night is potluck
- breakfasts will be cereal/fruit, pancakes
- lunches will be sandwiches/hamburgers/hotdogs/tacos

### What to bring:

- sleeping bag, pillow, your own water bottle, toiletries, changes of clothes, snacks, swim clothes for water play activities, covered shoes
- pack like you are going camping
