LAPA COVID-19 Policies and Procedures

- All staff members and students will arrive to LAPA wearing a mask.
 Disposable masks will be provided if students do not have one.
- Parents will need to sign COVID-19 waiver form (Google Forms)
- Before each class, students and instructors will be given hand sanitizer.
- Students and instructors will need to pass temperature checks before each class session. If a student or instructor has a temperature over 100 degrees, they will not be able to participate in class and will be sent home.
- There will be a maximum of 9 students (plus one instructor) per class with six feet distance markers between students.
- All classes will be held outdoors. In the case of bad weather, an alternate outdoor roofed location will be used, or class will be canceled for the day. If possible, class will be offered virtually that day.
- If student shows any signs of runny nose, cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, unusual headache, unexplained muscle and/or joint pain, chills, fever, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, loss of sense of smell, pink eye, or signs of increased fatigue, they will be asked to return home
- During all class time, students will be separated by a minimum of 6 feet.
 Students and instructors must wear masks at all times
- Any class materials (audio equipment, etc.) will not be shared between students
- No food during class (water bottles only)
- No phones will be allowed during classes (except for instructor, who will not share). Students may use their phones after classes, but will not be able to share with other students. If a student needs to use an instructor's phone, the instructor will make the phone call and place the student on speaker phone (without student touching the phone).
- If a student or instructor tests positive for COVID-19, all other students and instructors who were in close physical proximity will be asked to quarantine for 14 days
